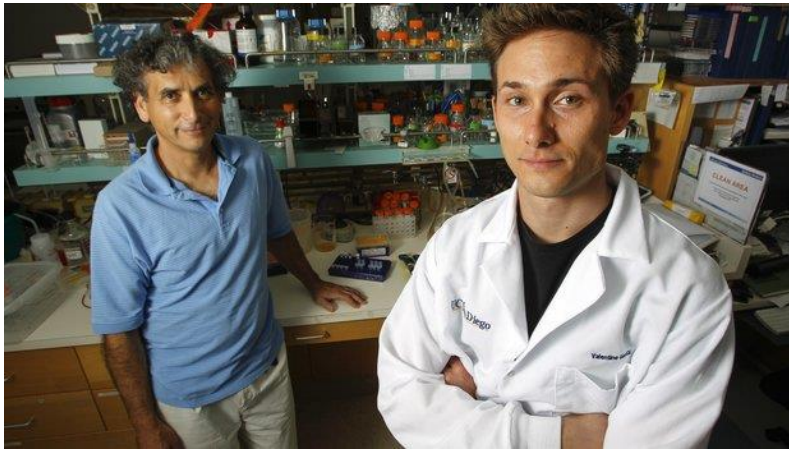


# Biomedical Ethics Seminar Series
